SCHOLARSHIP RULES/REGULATIONS

Perini Green Weekend is pleased to announce the 2009 **Perini Green Weekend SCHOLARSHIP FOUNDATION** program. This scholarship program has been established to encourage young adults to further their education in the field of Engineering and/or Construction Management and to assist those individuals in the preparation of their future career endeavors.

CRITERIA

- Scholarships may be awarded to a Title I or At Risk School graduating senior with a projected graduation date of May 2009.
- Student must enroll into an accredited college of Engineering and/or Construction Management in Southern Nevada (i.e. University of Nevada Las Vegas, College of Southern Nevada, ITT and Nevada State College).
- Student must major in; Construction Management, Electrical Engineering, Mechanical Engineering, Civil Engineering, or Architecture.
- Student must graduate high school with a grade point average of not less than 2.5 on a point system of 4.0.

REVIEW AND AWARD

- The Scholarship Selection Committee of the Perini Green Weekend Scholarship Foundation shall review all nominations and make recommendations of qualified individuals to the Perini Green Weekend Board of Directors. The Perini Green Weekend Board of Directors will make decisions on actual awards, in number and dollar amounts, to deserving nominees who meet all of the eligibility requirements and submit a complete nomination package. The Board reserves the right not to award scholarships in any given year if deemed appropriate.

NOMINATIONS

- Nominations must include the following information pertaining to the nominee.
 1. A completed application form.
 2. Three endorsement letters from any of the following sources (Please do not submit more than one letter from any one individual). * One letter must come from an educator:
 - Past or present teacher, principal and/or professor, or guidance counselor.
 - Past or present employer.
 - Mentor or professional from a community service or volunteer organization.
 3. Current official high school transcript (with seal).
 4. A "Doghouse" design by the student nominee to be a minimum of 1000 words
 - Choose a type of dog and research its history, talents and personality tendencies. Look for other critical information such as size, temperament, etc.
 - Develop a design for your doghouse and write an essay of a minimum of 1000 words about your selected dog and explanation of your design.
 - Provide sketches, drawings, renderings and/or model to back-up the design of your doghouse.
 5. A one page essay written by the student nominee to include:
 - Why are you pursuing a career in Engineering/Construction Management/Architecture?
 - What separates you from other students pursuing a career in your chosen field?
 - How do you think you will influence the profession in a positive and productive manner?

7. Nomination Deadline:

Nominations and letters of endorsement must be received by the Foundation at the aforementioned address **NO LATER THAN MONDAY, MARCH 2nd 2009 AT 4:30 PM. NO EXCEPTIONS. Any applications postmarked after that date will be disqualified.**

8. Form and Procedures of Receiving Award:

- The Perini Green Weekend Board of Directors will make decisions on actual awards, in number and dollar amounts, to deserving nominees who meet all of the eligibility requirements and submit a complete nomination package. The Board reserves the right not to award scholarships in any given year if deemed appropriate.
- Scholarship funds are electronically transmitted to the student's fee account. Money shall be used for verifiable education expenses only.

9. Notification:

- Nominees selected will be notified in writing by the Foundation on or about May 1st, 2009. Scholarships will be awarded according to the Perini Green Weekend Board of Directors discretion.
- The review process will take 6 – 8 weeks.
- Recipients will be notified by mail, e-mail, and a follow-up phone call.

10. Recipient Expectations:

- Recipients of the Scholarships shall continue to pursue a major in; Construction Management, Electrical Engineering, Mechanical Engineering, Civil Engineering, or Architecture.
- Recipients are expected to maintain a grade point average of 2.5 or above based on a point system of 4.0.
- Recipients will be expected to represent themselves in an appropriate and positive manner.
- Verification of diploma.

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SCHOLARSHIP AGREEMENT

This agreement is between _____ (The Scholarship Recipient) and The Perini Green Weekend Scholarship Foundation – (The “Foundation”).

I, _____ (The Scholarship Recipient) will abide by the following conditions in order to keep The Perini Green Weekend Scholarship and, if applicable, any other monies provided by the Foundation. I acknowledge that I am being upheld to certain academic criteria and behavior standards while on scholarship.

1. FULL CREDIT LOAD: The Recipient will take nothing less than a full credit load of 12 credits per semester.
2. PERFORMANCE: The Recipient will graduate from college in a maximum of 4 years, unless specifically extended by the foundation.
3. GRADE POINT AVERAGE: The Recipient will maintain at least a 2.5 grade point average per semester unless a higher grade point average is required by the College of Engineering, Construction Management and/or Architecture. Failure to maintain the minimum standard of grade point average per semester will result in a possible one semester probation. All disciplinary action is at the discretion of the Perini Green Weekend Board of Directors.
4. VERIFICATION OF ENROLLMENT: The Recipient must meet with an advisor from the College of Engineering, Construction Management and/or Architecture at the beginning of each semester in order to guarantee that all classes taken are supportive of their curriculum.
5. “DROPPING A CLASS”: The Recipient is not permitted to “drop” a class, unless otherwise advised to do so by an advisor of the College of Engineering, Construction Management and/or Architecture. If the Recipient decides to drop a class after the “full refund” period, it will be the responsibility for the Recipient to make up the class credit in the four year period aforementioned.
6. CONDUCT: The Recipient must conduct his/herself in an “appropriate manner while on campus and off”. This includes, but is not limited to:
 - a. No illegal use of any drugs or alcohol.
 - b. No disturbing the peace.
 - c. No lewd behavior.
 - d. No campus violations.
